The year wise details of the same is given below:

- NIRDESH society was re-structured in October 2021 and the present governing body consists of 04 DPSU shipyards only with co-opted members from Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard and DRDO. Government of India is not direct member in the governing body. The Chairman of NIRDESH is CMD, MDL.
- 2. The land which was allotted to NIRDESH society by Govt of Kerala is having a G+1 building with facilities for undertaking training, seminars etc. Many R&D projects were undertaken in the past. The similar activities will continue.
- 3. NIRDESH has tied up with M/s ASAP, a PSU of Government of Kerala, for setting up a Skill park in NIRDESH land, for imparting vocational training to aspirants in Shipbuilding trades. The construction of the facility is underway and likely to be setup

by mid-2024. A portion of NIRDESH land has been handed over to ASAP with concessionaire agreement for the purpose.

- 4. Balance land will also be utilised in accordance with future programs.
- c) Whether Government plan to transfer NIRDESH land to State Government. If so details thereof;

1. As on date there are no plans to transfer NIRDESH land back to Govt. of Kerala.
