

Reply: MDL allocated a total CSR funds of Rs 46.42 crore over past three financial years i.e. FY 2021-22, FY 2022-23 & FY 2023-24 based on section 198 of Companies Act, 2013 (i.e. two per cent of the average net profits of the company made during the three immediately preceding financial years). The year wise details of the same is given below:
